**AMERICAN EAGLE AIRLINES TO LAUNCH NONSTOP JET SERVICE BETWEEN  
PENSACOLA, FLA., AND MIAMI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT**

**New Nonstop Service Begins April 6, 2010**

PENSACOLA, Fla. – American Eagle Airlines, the regional affiliate of American Airlines, will begin nonstop jet service with two daily flights between Pensacola Gulf Coast Regional Airport (PNS) and Miami International Airport (MIA), beginning April 6, 2010. American Eagle will operate the service with 50-seat Embraer ERJ-145 jets.

“We’re delighted to offer this new service to Pensacola,” said Gary Foss, American Eagle’s Vice President – Planning and Marketing. “Combined with our daily non-stop service from Dallas/Fort Worth, customers throughout the Pensacola Bay area will have even greater access to American’s global network.”
